

Faculty Position, Computer Science

The Department of Computer Science at Southern Illinois University Edwardsville (SIUE) invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position. As part of the SIUE School of Engineering, the Department offers an ABET-accredited B.S. degree program as well as B.A. and M.S. Computer Science degree programs. The department has twelve full-time faculty members and more than 450 students.

Diversity, equity, and inclusion are core values of SIUE and reflected in the institutional commitment to Inclusive Excellence here <https://www.siu.edu/provost/inclusive-excellence/>. The School of Engineering is committed to attracting, supporting, and retaining employees with varying identities and backgrounds, particularly candidates from underrepresented groups in STEM such as women faculty and faculty of color. SIUE faculty are encouraged to contribute to inclusive excellence in both the academic community and region through research, teaching, and service.

Minimum Qualifications

- A Ph.D. in computer science or related area is required. ABD candidates may be considered.
- All applicants must have a demonstrated interest in teaching and mentoring in computer science, at both the undergraduate and graduate level.
- Applicants must have a demonstrated interest in developing a quality research program and in attracting external research funding.

Terms of Appointment

It is anticipated that the appointment will be made at the Assistant Professor, although other levels of Associate Professor and Professor will be considered. The salary of the new faculty member will be commensurate with experience. Responsibilities include undergraduate and graduate instruction, research, as well as university and public service. Candidates for this position will be expected to be student-centered and should embrace the Teacher-Scholar model, demonstrate a commitment to promoting experiential learning, and advance computer science through research. Faculty members are encouraged to perform research with graduate students and serve on thesis committees. Candidates are also encouraged to engage in interdisciplinary collaboration. The position is expected to begin in August 2022.

Application Process

Submit a letter of application that includes a research statement; a statement on teaching philosophy; a statement that discusses their philosophies, experiences, and/or competencies in supporting equity, inclusion, and diversity; a curriculum vitae; and contact information for at least three references in one file in PDF format via email to cs-search@siue.edu. Each statement should be no more than two pages. Questions should be directed to Chair of Faculty Search Committee 2022, Department of Computer Science, SIUE, Edwardsville, IL 62026-1656. All application materials must be received by January 16, 2022.
